

**By-Laws of the
Albany Sports Boosters Club**

ARTICLE I: PURPOSE

The Albany Sports Booster Club is an organization of parents and community members who support the various athletic programs of the Albany School District. The purpose of the organization is to raise funds to support projects and athletic programs in the Albany school district that may otherwise go unfunded.

ARTICLE II: OFFICERS

The officers of this organization shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Snack Bar Coordinator. The duties include the following:

President: Preside over meetings, call special meetings, and appoint committees.

Vice-President: Take over duties of President in case of absence or disability of President.

Treasurer: To look after funds of the club and give financial report at each meeting.

Secretary: To take and maintain record of all official meetings.

Snack Bar Coordinator: To keep snack bar stocked, organized and maintained.

All offices are filled by election with the person receiving the largest number of votes filling the office. Election of new officers shall be held at the May meeting. Officers shall take office immediately, and shall serve a 1 year term.

ARTICLE III: MEETINGS

Membership is open to anyone who demonstrates interest in being involved. The club will hold regular meetings. Special meetings may be called by the President. The time and place of each meeting will be determined at the previous meeting.

ARTICLE IV: AMENDMENTS

An amendment to these by-laws may be proposed by any club member and it shall be passed by a simple majority of officers present at a meeting. Since the Albany Sports Booster Club is a school related organization, its Constitution is subject to approval by the Albany Board of Education. Revisions of the By-Laws will require the Board of Education's approval. Actions and activities of the membership are also subject to the school board's approval.
